Incidents: → DARK RED DAUPHIN - VBIED BASRAH - HAMMAM DISCRETE

1) US 178 Arty reported UXO (2x Mortar rd) at grid QU 61427 37848. This closed the Safwan border crossing, until a US c/s could deal with the incident. Circle confirmed open at 1202 using a detour. ATO tasked to remove threat.

2) An explosion was heard by a 7 LSR convoy 50m east of route 6. Initial ing reports suggest that this was a landmine/uxo triggered by cattle. Ato investigated but could not determine the cause. QV 192875

3) A civilian c/s reports that at grid qv 194 678, local intelligence informed them of a possible ambush. Weapons were also seen on 2x pick-up trucks in the area. It is believed to be part of a feud between IPS and a criminal gang. IPS continues to investigate GR 294 678

4) At 162145cdec04 1wg reported that 2x veh were approaching to a vcp at gr qv 210 861, but turned around when they saw the vcp. Ips followed the car. There were 6x pax, and 1x of them was an ips. 2x illegal weapons have been confiscated. No arrest has been made.

BASRAH PROVINCE

01	ATTACK ON IPS.	C/S passed IPS CP at GR (QU 8097346) just after it was attacked by masked men wearing IPS uniform, who arrived in seven cars. No shooting took place, but the IPS officers were beaten. The CP was reinforced by approx 70 IPS who did not stay overnight.	It could be assessed that this raid was crime related and that further intimidation of the IPS in AO will continue.
02	BRIG [redacted] MEETING	IPSLO from CPAT was informed that Brig [redacted] would no longer be prepared to attend future meetings with MNF or IPA/CPATT. The IPA then called Brig [redacted] with a request that he come to the SAAH to clarify his current position and agreed to meet at 151130CDEC. Brig [redacted] appeared upset and frustrated over the current support from MNF. [redacted] stated that a communiqué had been received confirming him as BASRA CoP. [redacted] indicated that he had met with the CO 1 DWR on 12 Dec 04 and requested assistance to remove Brig [redacted] from position, and claimed that CO 1 DWR had agreed, but had to forward the request through the chain of command. Due to lack of progress [redacted] then stated that he would visit the US consulate later, 151800CDEC04, as advised by the MOI. The outcome of the meeting would then be made known to the IPA/CPATT. [redacted] stated that the Governor had countermanded orders from the MOI regarding funding, and that he [redacted] stated that he intended not to pay police salaries until IPS officers forced Brig [redacted] out of office.	[redacted] stated that he has been given permission to use Force to remove [redacted] from his position, and he is quoted as saying, "I am preparing steps to take power". [redacted] explained that he would use military force to remove [redacted] he stated that he had spoken with numerous political and religious leaders, as well as members of the IPS and has their support. This vein of reporting suggests that there may be concerns for a potential split in the IPS, by those who follow [redacted] and those which follow [redacted]. This is likely to make the security situation become increasingly unstable around the elections.

MAYSAN PROVINCE

03	Maysan Atmospherics	During an informal meeting with members of the JOCC in CAN, it was reported that the locals are at breaking point due to the unavailability of vital commodities and resources, and that it was only a matter of time before they display anger towards the MNF. The main issues raised were that the electricity supply is 1 hour in 5 hours at best, the reduction of rations and the lack of availability in the shops, no sugar or detergents, and deterioration in the water quality.	There are reports that there is action threatened against the MNF if the situation does not improve. Reported threats of direct action are more frequent, the latest being in Maysan province

Int Cell Assessment: A quiet day across the AO, with a single possible IED near the junction of Route 6 and the road into Camp CONDOR, and a single probable IED in BASRAH City. The question of who is actually the CoP in BASRAH City remains unresolved, and there are further reports of divisions within the IPS. There are further reports of the detrimental affect that the continued difficulties with the electricity supply and water continue to have on the attitude of the local population.
